Children aged 8 years and over will be participating in the "swimming scheme" with a trained swimming instructor. The children aged below 8 years will be participating in water awareness activities in the fountain pool and shallow end of the big pool.

It is expected that all children will participate in swimming. If for some reason your child/ren are unable to participate in swimming, can you please let the school know before swimming commences. Your child/ren will still have to go in to the Young Aquatic Centre as there will be no supervision at school.
