All students are to wear their summer uniform, school hat and to take a water bottle as it is going to be a hot afternoon.

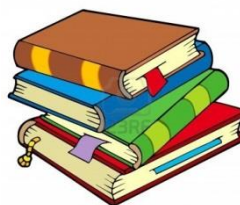
Scripture
