Healthy Lunch

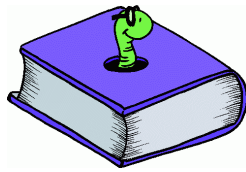
We have noticed that there are students who are still bringing unhealthy lunches to school.
