Can't Wait for School

Preparing to transition your child from home and/or an early childhood setting into primary school can be an emotional time for parents and children, regardless of whether it is your first child or last child heading off to school, each child has their own unique personality and way of dealing with change. One of the best ways to prepare your child for this transition is to have strong relationships with your child's current educators in an early childhood setting and build a relationship with the school they will be attending. The educators in Young recognise the importance of this and network regularly to ensure the schools and early childhood settings have an open and productive relationship to provide the best opportunity for your child's transition into a primary school setting. This network of educators in Young is known as the YES group (Young Early Childhood Services) who have planned an evening for parents of preschool age children, heading to school in 2017 or 2018. This evening will include presentations on the important aspects of the transition to school process and what parents can do to help their child. This evening will be held at the Young Services and Citizens Club on Thursday **25th August at 7pm**. This year an on-site crèche will be provided, to assist those families who are unable to find care for their children. 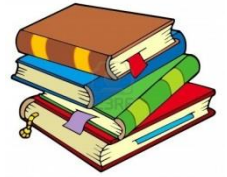
