There will be a canteen available on the day – no pre-ordering necessary.

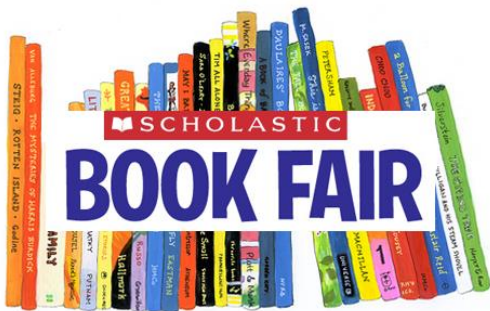
## Book Fair
