Also, thank you to parents who were able to help out on the day with events, taking photos, setting up and packing up.

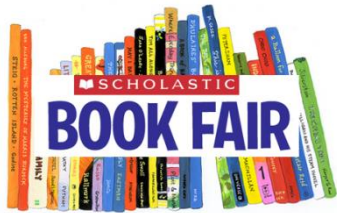

Swimming Scheme

Swimming Scheme is held each year and runs for two weeks. This year it will begin on Monday 20th November and finish up

on Friday 1st December. This is an intensive swimming program for Years 3 – 6 with the infants students learning water safety skills and water confidence.

Swimming Scheme is held at the Young Aquatic Centre between 10.40am and 11.20am. The students will be bussed to and from the pool each day.

We have been very fortunate to secure a Sporting Schools Grant which will cover the cost of the bus and admission into the pool.

Your child will need to wear their swimmers to school under their uniform.

Please remember to pack dry underwear and a plastic bag for their wet swimmers and towel to go in.

All students will be involved in swimming. If your child has a medical reason for not swimming, please let the school know.

Unfortunately, the primary students involved in the Sydney Primary Excursion will miss out on the first week's swimming.

Primary Science – Do you know how much salt will dissolve in a glass of water?

In Science, the primary class have been learning about how substances change. Last week they performed an experiment in collaborative teams to see how much salt dissolved in a glass of water. They observed that 8 teaspoons of salt dissolved in a 200ml glass of water. How salty would that water taste!
