Britney Long - for improved attitude and behaviour at school

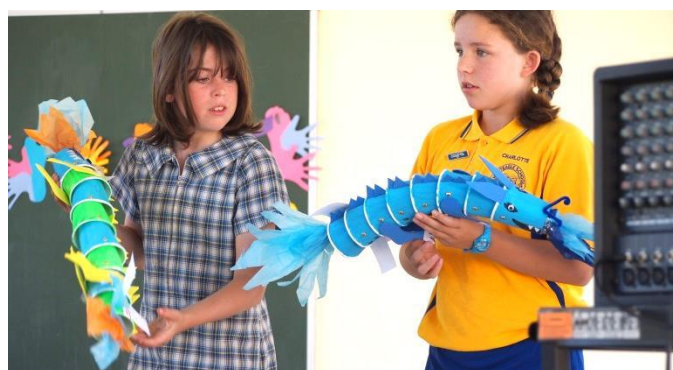
Daniella Cummins - for writing a great Haiku

All students will be involved in swimming. If your child has a medical reason for not swimming, please let the school know.

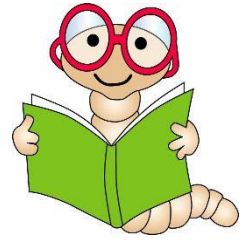
Students will not be allowed to buy anything from the canteen. We will have fruit break before we leave school and will have lunch when we return.
