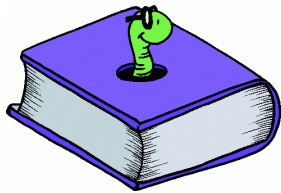
Thank you to those families who made a donation. We were able to give the Royal Far West \$40 to put towards their charity ride.
