School team was very impressed with our boy's commitment and behaviour – so congratulations boys for representing your school with pride.



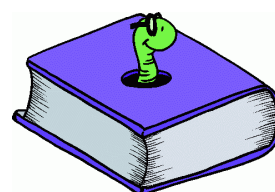
## District Cross Country
