YSS Art Exhibition

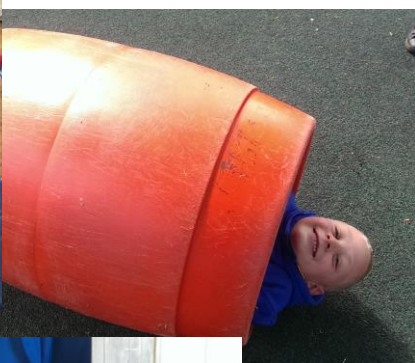
