Fishing Club Donation

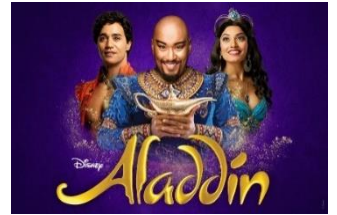
Last week we had an unexpected phone call from the Young District Angler's Association advising us that we were the latest recipients of their raffle fundraising proceeds.
