Year 3 – Monique Cummins – Highly Commended

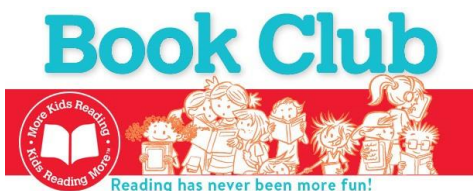
