On Tuesday, the Life Education Van visited our school along with their mascot - Heathy Harold. The Life Ed Van gives your children the information, understanding, skills and strategies they require to make safe decisions about their own health and well-being.

The infants students were taught problem solving, personal safety, seeking help, how to care for others and behaviours that maintain friendships.

The Years 3 – 4 students explored cyber safety through animation, vox pops of children, relevant scenarios, discussion and problem solving.

The Years 5 – 6 were taught knowledge, skills and attitudes that children need to develop and maintain safe and respectful relationships both on and offline. Including effective communication skills, development of empathy and conflict resolution skills.

The students from Murringo School also joined us on the day. When students were not in the Life Ed Van they joined together for a game of t-ball, board games and classroom activities. These were great activities in building teamwork, resilience and trust.

There will be an announcement on the radio that morning if it needs to be postponed.

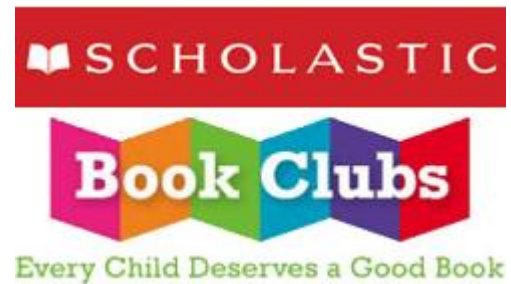
Arabin Cup

Canteen

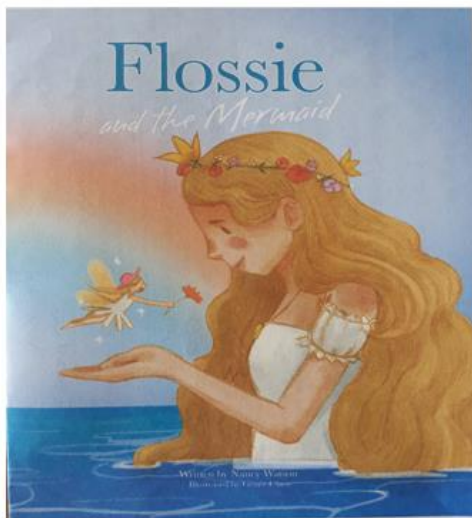
